In addition to the \$5,278.87, we raised \$3,700 from the 50/50 raffle for a grand total of **\$8,978.87** for the day. I still can't believe it!!

It was a great day all around. The weather was wonderful and we had over 30 volunteers for the day who worked so well together. As a result, we logged 281 volunteer hours in one day. I believe that two things really made this year such a great success. The first is that we had a generous non-LACC gentleman donate several Christmas trees and a bowflex machine in the fall of 2010. These items were sold on craigs list before Christmas. There were also several items sold a week or two before the yard sale. Therefore, going into the yard sale, we had already raised \$805. The second is that Scott Sanfason donated a 14 foot Meyers aluminum boat with a trailer that was sold at the yard sale for \$400. Thank you Scott for your generosity. Your donation really helped make our day such a great success.

Before I disclose the results of the big raffle, I would just like to mention that the Romanecks were extremely generous and donated a large bin of great diving equipment including wet suits, vests, lights, knives etc. for sale at the yard sale. Unfortunately, these items did not sell, but they will be offered to our divers for spare equipment and they will be put to good use, and it will save LACC and our divers money on spare parts.

As you all know, we also had the drawing for the BIG 50/50 cash raffle at the close of the yard sale. Unfortunately, we did not sell all 500 tickets. Since this was the first year for our big raffle, the Board of Directors voted to payout the full prizes instead of a percentage of the ticket sales. Going into the yard sale, we sold 389 tickets, and at the yard sale, we sold another 46 tickets for a total of 435 tickets sold. Therefore, LACC paid out \$5,000 in prizes and raised \$3,700 to help fight milfoil. The winners of the big raffle were:
