

Lake Arrowhead Bingo Night – August 26, 2017 – Sotir Hall (Clubhouse 2)

6pm Start (Doors open at 5pm)

Entry:

- Seating will be first come first served subject to the hall limit of 75 people (including volunteers running the event).
- Entry will be \$20 for one sheet of 9 cards per game or \$15 for two sheets of 3 cards per game. Additional sheets of 3 cards per game will be sold for each game at the beginning of the night only for \$5.
- Daubers will be sold for \$2 each.
- Raffles will be sold before BINGO begins (5-6pm). These will include raffles for future prizes (LACC 50/50, donated items, etc.) and one free raffle will be pulled at the start of BINGO for a free \$15 entry into next month's BINGO game.
- Light refreshments such as chips, water, and soda will be available for \$1 each. You may bring your own refreshments if you wish, but alcohol is strictly prohibited.

Game Structure:

- There will be 10 games during the course of the evening in sequential order 1-10.
- There will be approximately a 15 minute break between games 5 and 6.
- Games 1-4 and 6-9 will be "regular" BINGO games where the winner will be the first to get a traditional BINGO (straight line in any direction, including diagonal) OR all four corners.
- Games 5 and 10 will be "special" games which will consist of regular BINGO followed by making an "X" pattern (Game 5) and a cover-all (Game 10).
- All regular BINGO payouts will be 5% of the night's buy-in (up to max of \$100). So, if 50 people play for \$20 each, each regular BINGO will pay out \$50.
- The "X" game winner will pay out 10% of the night's buy-in (up to max of \$200). So, if 50 people play for \$20, the winner of this game gets \$100.
- The cover-all game will pay out 15% of the night's buy-in (up to max \$300). So, if 50 people play for \$20, the winner of this game gets \$150.
- A BINGO can only occur after each number is called.
- In the event of a tie in any game, the winners shall evenly split the payout. This shall include any BINGOs called on a prior number.

Rules:

- ONLY Lake Arrowhead and Lake Arrowhead Conservation Council members and their guests are invited to play – at check-in, you will be required to provide your name and Lake Arrowhead address.
- No alcohol may be present in the BINGO hall or on the premises at any time during the event.
- All players must be at least 16 years old and minors are only allowed accompanied by an adult.
- No pets allowed.
- No smoking except in areas designated outside the clubhouse.
- All winners are solely responsible for the payment of any federal and state income taxes.

Final word: this event is being put on by a group of volunteers in the community to bring the community together in a fun way to support Lake Arrowhead. The volunteers are not being paid and this is the first time Lake Arrowhead is offering this event. We intend to host an event monthly for the rest of the year to see if there is continued interest. At first, we will not have the best technology and there will be bumps in the road. We'd like to see it succeed and become a weekly or bi-weekly game in the future (with electric board, pull tabs, etc.) so we ask for everybody to be patient, have fun, and work with us to make this a long-term success for the community.
